Dear Parents/Carers,

An excursion has been organised for Year Five students and the students from 5/6L to visit the Minnamurra Rainforest Centre as part of their environmental studies.

Minnamurra Rainforest Centre lies within Budderoo National Park, 15 km west of Kiama. It has a network of boardwalks and paved tracks. The visitor centre is a multi-award-winning tourism destination which gives students and visitors the chance to experience a rare remnant of the rainforests that were once extensive throughout the Illawarra region.

The students will participate in a guided walk, utilising the specially built boardwalks, to experience the rainforest flora and fauna. They will also view a special presentation by NSW Parks and Wildlife Service.

Time: Students need to be at school **by 7.45am.**

Travel: Bus

Cost: There will be no cost for this excursion. The school will cover the cost for students.

Lunch: Students are asked to bring their recess, lunch and drinks in a small backpack.
